Registration with the Roll of the Luxembourg Bar Association (hereinafter the "Bar")

The Bar, in its capacity as data controller, collects and processes personal data, the purpose of which is the administration of the Bar and in particular the maintenance of the roll of the Bar, the duties required by legal aid, the charging of lawyers' fees and expenses, the drafting of opinions on legal matters, and more generally the examination of all issues relating to the practice of the profession and the defence of lawyers' rights.

Data collection is limited to the information required to fulfil these purposes. Mandatory data are indicated as such on the collection forms. These data are intended for all authorised persons from the Bar and for the Ministry of Justice. The data will be kept for a period of 60 years and will be recorded and secured in a computerised file (secured cloud) managed by POST Luxembourg located at 20, rue de Reims in Luxembourg, Luxembourg.

The legal basis for the processing is Article 18 of the Law of 10 August 1991 on the legal profession.

Annuaire des Avocats (Lawyers' Directory)

Your surname, first name, business e-mail address and business phone number will also be published on our website under "Annuaire des Avocats" (Lawyers' Directory) (https://www.barreau.lu/votre-avocat/annuaire-des-avocats) in the public interest to enable the public to check that the lawyer concerned is actually registered on the Roll of the Bar. These data will be kept until the end of your activities.

Your rights

You have the right to obtain from the Bar confirmation as to whether or not personal data relating to you are being processed and, if so, access to such personal data as well as the following information:

- the categories of personal data collected and processed;
- the purposes for which they are processed;
- the categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been disclosed or are likely to be disclosed;
- the storage period of the personal data;
- information about your rights in respect of your personal data.

Right to object

You may object, on legitimate grounds, to any processing of your personal data. Thus, the Bar shall no longer process your personal data unless it demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Right to rectification

You can request that your personal data be rectified if they prove to be inaccurate, incomplete or obsolete.

Right to be forgotten

As the holder of this right to be forgotten, you may request that your personal data be erased on simple request. However, this right is not absolute and may, for example, conflict with the legitimate interests of the data controller – or with the legal obligations to which the latter is subject.

Right to restriction of processing

You may demand that the Bar rectify, complete, update, lock or erase any personal data concerning you that are inaccurate, incomplete, equivocal, out of date or the collection, use, communication or storage of which is prohibited.

Right to data portability

You have the right to receive your personal data collected or processed by the Bar in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and the rights to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the Bar to which the personal data have been provided.
